I. The Command: Stop <u>Deceiving</u> Yourselves: 'Be Not / Do Not Be Deceived' 1 Cor. 6:9

"Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived:

- A. The Greek (μή πλανάσθε) the Negative Particle μή Plus a Verb in the Present Tense and Imperative Mood Which the Verb Translated 'Deceived' (πλανάσθε)
 Means To <u>Stop</u> Doing Something That You Are Currently Doing = <u>Quit</u>
 Deceiving Yourselves
 - 1. Believers Are <u>Personally Responsible</u> to Not Allow Themselves to Be Deceived cf 1 Cor. 6:9; 15:33, Gal. 6:7; Eph. 5:6*; Col. 2:8; Heb. 3:13; James 2:15; 2 Pet. 3:17; 1 Jn. 3:7
 - 2. Things Believers Are Either to Do, to *Know* or Beware of in Order to *Protect*Themselves Against the Deception of Sin

e. *'Put off The Old Man'* cf Eph. 4:22-24; Col. 3:9-10: The *Old man, The Sin Nature, The Flesh;* We Put Off The Old Man By *Knowing, Believing* and *Applying* the Teaching of Rm. 6:6-23

- 6) <u>Instead</u> of Placing any Part of Your Body That The Sin Nature Desires to Use for Unrighteousness, at Its Disposal; Place It at <u>God's</u> Disposal to Use for Righteousness Rm. 6:13°
- 7) <u>Stop</u> Making <u>Provision</u> for the Flesh cf Rm. 13:14^b Will Include, <u>Deliberately</u> Avoiding That Which <u>Stimulates</u> the Desires of the Flesh, (i.e. Sin Nature, Old Man) to Sin, (i.e. do things that are prohibited by the Scriptures.)
- 8) Put <u>On</u> The New Man (The New Creation in You, Who Is Created in the *Image of Christ* cf Eph. 4:23-24; Col. 3:10 Rm. 13:11-14; 2 Cor. 5:17
