The Theological Impact

- 1. God's Means of Deliverance from or Protection through Troublesome Times May Be Different from What I Desired or Expected but Will Always Be the Best Way
- 2. God Provides Deliverance from or Protection through Troublesome Times to Believers Who Place Their Complete Trust in Him
- 3. God Has Determined to Allow Believers to Participate in His Deliverance of Themselves or Others or Their Own Protection and the Protection of Others through Troublesome Times by Means of Prayer
- 4. God Is to Receive All the Credit and All the Glory for the Believer's Deliverance from or Protection through Troublesome Times
- 5. Believers Who Do Not Seek God for Deliverance from or Protection through Troublesome Times May Not Be Delivered or Protected
