2. The **Five Primary** Ways in Which God Answers Prayer

- a. **Immediate** Affirmative of 2 Ki. 20:1-5; Acts 9:40; 12:3-11; 28:8
- b. **Deferred** Affirmative of Gen. 15:2-4 of Gen. 16:16; Ex. 2:23 – 12:51
Deut. 3:23-26 with Mt. 17:1-3; Neh. 1:1-2:6; Lk. 1:5-13; Philipp. 1:19
- c. Affirmative But Not in the **Way** You **Expected** of Nu. 11:10-25; 21:5-9;
Lk. 8:38; 2 Cor. 12:8-9
 - 1) The **People** Sin The **Punishment**, The People **Plead**, The **Prayer**, The **Pole** and The **Profoundly** Different Answer of Nu. 21:5-9
 - a) The **People** Sin of Nu. 21:5
 - b) God's **Punishment: Poisonous** Snakes Are Sent to Bite the Sinful People of Nu. 21:6
 - c) The People **Plead** with Moses and **Profess** They Have Sinned of Nu. 21:7
 - d) God **Provided** an Answer to the Peoples' Prayer That Was **Positive** but **Profoundly** Different from the Peoples' Expectation Nu. 21:8-9
 - e) **Points of Conclusion** Concerning the Profoundly Different Answer to the Prayer of the People
 - i. **God** Provided the Means of the Healing
 - ii. There Was Only **ONE** Solution

- iii. The Remedy Was Available to **Everyone**
- iv. The Remedy Was Offered to All on the Basis of God's **Grace**
- v. The Remedy Could Only Be Made Effective by **Faith**

Theological Impact

1. Trials, Tribulations, Sufferings Often **Move** People to Pray and Teach Them the **Value** of Prayer
2. Do Not Regard the **Grace** of God Lightly or with Contempt
3. God Can Be Trusted to Give the **Most** Effectual Relief to Us in a Manner That Will Always be the **Best** for Us Even Though It May Not Be the **Way** We Thought Would Be Best for Us
4. It Was God Himself Who **Devised** and **Prescribed** the Way to Be Saved from the Deadly Bites of the Venomous Snakes
5. God's Remedy May Require **More** Faith or **Continued** Faith before Being Made Effective
