<i>Emotional Human Enthusiasm</i>	<i>Biblical Zeal</i>
<p>When Human Emotional Enthusiasm Masquerading as Zeal is Brought into the Realm of 'Supposed Service to God' (i.e. religious realm) The Supposed <u>Zealot</u> is Really Promoting His or Her Self and is Not <u>Glorifying</u> God cf Gal. 4:17 with Gal. 6:13; Philipp. 3:4-6 with Gal. 1:14, 21-24; Acts 22:3; 2 Ki. 10:16 with 2 Ki. 10:29-31; Jn. 16:2 with Acts 4:17, 21; 5:17, 33, 49; 8:3; 9:1-2; 14:15, 19; 17:13; 18:12; 19:23-42; 20:27-31; Rm. 2:17, 23; 10:2-4</p>	<p>Will always <u>Glorify / Honor the Lord</u>; The Examples of <i>David</i> cf 1 Sam. 17:23-50; Psalm 69:9; 132:1-5; 2 Sam. 7:1-2; 1 Chr. 22:1-5, 6-19; 10:21; <i>Elijah</i> cf 1 Ki. 19:10, 14; <i>Meshach, Shadrach, Abednego</i> cf Dan 3:1-30; <i>Daniel</i> cf Dan. 6:1-28; <i>Stephen</i> cf Acts 6:8-7:64</p>

<p>Must Continually Be Stimulated with <u>Promises</u> of <u>Blessings</u> to Move One to Give Unto the Lord: <i>Word of Faith Movement / Faith Promise Giving</i></p>	<p>Will be Move by <u>Love</u> for the Lord and <i>Having Been Blessed</i> by the Lord to Give Unto the Lord in Accordance with New Testament Teaching</p>

- 2) Paul's Prayer for the Philippians Reveals That **Fruit** in the Life of a Believer **Glorifies** God of Philipp. 1:9-11

- a) He Prays That Their **Love** Might Continue **Growing** of Philipp. 1:9

i. This Is Something Paul **Regularly** Seeks God for on Behalf of the Philippians: The Words 'I Pray' Are the Translation of the Greek Verb (προσεύχομαι); English Transliteration *proseuchomai*) Is in the Present Tense Form, Expressing Paul Continued to Seek This on the Occasions *When* He Called These Believers to Mind of Philipp. 1:3-4

ii. The Object of the Words 'Your Love' Is Not Stated in the Verse But the *Object is Probably* **God** First, and Then Also, One **Another** and the **Lost** Are *Probably* in View As Well

- iii. Their Love Is to Grow in the Sphere of ***Knowledge***; Is the Translation of the Greek Word (ἐπίγνωσις); English Transliteration *Epignosis*; the Word Denotes the Thought of As ***Complete*** a Knowledge That God Gives of Himself and Our Lord Jesus Christ, That We in Our Present Fallen State Can Apprehend by the Working of God The Holy Spirit, That Is *Factual, True* and *Practical* in the Sense That We Can Apply It by Faith to Our Relationship with God and Others in Everyday Life cf Rm. 1:28; 3:20; 10:2; Eph. 1:17; Eph. 4:13; Col. 1:9-10; 2:2; 3:10; 1 Tim. 1:4; 2 Tim. 2:25; 3:7; Titus 1:1; Heb. 10:26; 2 Pet. 1:3, 8; 3:20
