The Words 'All Judgment' / 'Depth of Insight' / 'Discernment' Are the Translation of The Greek Word (αἲσθησις); English Transliteration aisthesis; Cognate Verb (αἰσθάνομαι); English Transliteration aisthanomai and Cognate Neuter Noun (αἰσθητήριον); English Transliteration aistheterion; in This Context the Word Means: To Have the Ability The Holy Spirit Gives to Believers Through the Strenuous Training of the New Inner Man Which Enables Believers to Correctly and Clearly Understand the Scriptures and the Things in Them That Are Spiritually Difficult to Comprehend and What the Word of God Says About

Things That May Be Considered *Tough Moral, Social, Contemporary Issues of Our Time* cf Lk. 9:44-45; Heb. 5:14

b) Purposes of Paul's Prayer of Philipp. 1:10

i. That Believers 'May Approve' / 'Be Able to Discern' / 'Help Determine' These Words Are the Translation of the Greek Word (δοκιμάζω); English Transliteration dokimazo; the Word Literally Means 'to assay, test'; in This Context the Word Means 'to Dissect' (i.e. to take apart and carefully analyze) Discern and Decide or in a Single Word Determine (the determining comes after CAREFULLY ANALYZING) of Lk. 12:56; Rm. 2:18; Rm. 12:2; 14:22; 1 Cor. 3:13; 2 Cor. 8:22; 13:15; Eph. 5:8, 10; 1 Thess. 5:21-22; 1 Tim. 3:10; 1 Jn. 4:1
