 God's <u>Plan</u> and His Present <u>Purpose</u> for Paul and his Gospel Team Was to go into Macedonia and Proclaim the Gospel cf Acts 16:6-10

"Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to proclaim the word in Asia," Acts 16:6

"After they were come Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia; but the Spirit allowed them not." Acts 16:7

"And they passing by Mysia, came down to Troas. And a vision appeared to Paul in the night: there stood a man of Macedonia, beseeching him, and saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us." Acts 16:9

"And after he had seen the vision, immediately, we endeavored to go <u>into Macedonia</u>, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us to proclaim the gospel unto them." Acts 16:10
